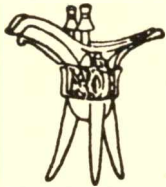

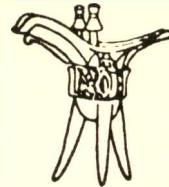


## ABOUT THE AUTHOR
